EU leaders endorse the 2050 Climate neutrality objective

2020

EU leaders discuss the EU's Climate ambition for 2030 and the Council adopts conclusions on the EU biodiversity strategy for 2030

2021

The Council and the Parliament reach a provisional agreement of reducing greenhouse gases (GHG) to 55% compared to 1990 by 2030

First formal minister debate about the Ff55 takes place



The official discussion on Ff55 begins

2022

Russian invasion of Ukraine leads to insecurity of energy supply - Ff55 needs to be reviewed as a result

The council adopts a common position on the Ff55 package

The Parliament votes to record nuclear power as renewable energy

2023

Discussions regarding sustainable aviation fuels are ongoing in the Parliament and the Council

Also FuelEU Maritime is being negotiated
